Victoria Street commits to our newcomer(s),

that we will do our part to successfully resettle you in the United States. **Victoria Street will help all work-ready adults in your household gain employment.** We will do this through a combination of one-on-one job coaching and making connections to hiring departments of local companies. No one can be more invested in your success than you. Victoria Street is here to help as much as we are able, but always remember that your success is first and foremost your responsibility. If you express a desire to not receive Victoria Street's help, we reserve the right to end this commitment to you.

For legal purposes, this statement of commitment is a unilateral expression of intent, and not a binding contract. Victoria Street will approach this work in good faith, with the ultimate goal of helping you attain self-sufficiency on a reasonably fast timeline. Successes and difficulties will be discussed openly. In the unlikely event of breakdown of this arrangement, Victoria Street will work in good faith to either repair the arrangement or leave this arrangement in good order with a "continuation plan" designed to minimize negative impact to you.

If this box is checked, Victoria Street is going to help you make your own housing arrangements. This may include: providing you with one or several housing options that reasonably meet the needs of your family, in the area in which you must resettle; providing links to applications you must fill out; helping you understand costs; helping you sign your own lease. If your lack of rental and credit history in the United States proves a barrier to securing housing, Victoria Street may be willing to "co-sign" your lease, to strengthen your application. However, Victoria Street is not a financial assistance organization, and your cost of housing must be arranged through direct or indirect financial support you receive from other sources. This could include funding provided through the federal government, personal gifts, loans, and other such routes.
